

InDesign Server Product Specific Terms of Use

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These Product Specific Terms govern your use of InDesign Server and are incorporated by reference into the Adobe General Terms of Use ("General Terms") located at www.adobe.com/go/terms (these Product Specific Terms and the General Terms are collectively referred to as "**Terms**"). Other Product Specific Terms incorporated by reference into the General Terms may also govern your use of the Services and Software. Capitalized terms not defined here have the same meaning as defined in the General Terms.

1. Additional Definitions.

1.1 "**Computer**" means a virtual or physical device for storing or processing data, such as servers, desktop computers, laptops, mobile devices, Internet-connected devices, and hardware products. Where a device contains more than one virtual environment (including virtual machines, virtual processors, and Containers), each virtual environment will be counted as a separate Computer.

1.2 "**Container**" means a virtualized and self-contained computing environment which contains all dependencies required to execute a contained software application.

1.3 "**Development License**" means a license that is restricted to non-production use for testing or staging and is for use with automated publishing solutions made accessible to customers or users via the internet or corporate wide within an Intranet.

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1.6 "**On-premise Software**" means the Adobe software that is deployed by or on behalf of you on hardware designated by you.

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1.8 "**User**" means an individual (either your employee or an independent contractor providing services to you) who may use or access the Services and Software.

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3.2 Those accessing the On-premise Software via an external network do not have any right to access or ability to use the On-premise Software for their own purposes any may only access and use the On-premise Software to interface with, or to use and extended service of, your direct beneficial business purpose; and

3.3 Any download of the On-premise Software, in whole or in part, is prohibited.

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
