These Product Specific Terms govern your use of Medium and are incorporated into the Adobe General Terms of Use (“**General Terms**”) located at www.adobe.com/go/terms (these Product Specific Terms and the General Terms are collectively referred to as “**Terms**”). Capitalized terms not defined here have the same meaning as defined in the General Terms.
